Time: 9 am to 4 pm


Venue: The B.J.P.C. Institution

Rules

- 1. This event is for XYZ Members only.
- 2. A list of events has been made for each age category.
- 3. Certain events require the children to carry things from home, while some will be provided to them.
- 4. All participants must carry their own stationery box containing pens, pencils, eraser, ruler, sharpener and a writing board (exam board).
- 5. Parents are requested to read the event details accurately to avoid any confusion.
- 6. Events will take place in 4 age groups (Date of Birth of child as on 31st October 2018)
 - Under 8 Children aged 4, 5, 6 & 7 years -- Born between 1-11-2014 and 31-10-2010
 - **Under 11 Children aged 8, 9 & 10 years --** Born between 1-11-2010and 31-10-2007
 - Under 14 Children aged 11, 12 & 13 years -- Born between 1-11-2007 and 31-10-2004
 - Under 17 Children aged 14, 15, & 16 years -- Born between 1-11-2004 and 31-10-2001
- 7. A child can participate in his/her own age category ONLY.
 - Eg. A child who is 9 years will participate in the Under 11 category only and not in Under 14.
- 8. The registration fee for this event is Rs. 300/- for all attending (irrespective of the number of events the child participates in) and this includes transportation and lunch.
- 9. Buses will be available for participants, volunteers and parents.
- 10. Parents will not be allowed to be in the classroom where the child is participating.
- 11. To register for this event, the child has to submit a registration form (ONLINE) on www.xyzfoundation.netenlisting the events he/she wishes to participate in. A copy of the PDF form will be sent back on email and that must be submitted to the group volunteers along with the registration fee of Rs. 300 by **Saturday, 10th November 2018.**
- 12. The decision of the judges and the organising committee of XYZ will be final.

















LOGIX (Puzzles) U8 / U11

- This is an individual event.
- Participants will be given written puzzles to solve in the shortest amount of time.

MECHANIX (Machine Building) U8

- This is an individual event.
- Participants will be given 60 minutes to build a moving model of their choice.
- All material will be brought by the children from home.

BLOX (Lego / Building blocks) U8 / U11

- This is an individual event.
- Participants will carry their own lego pieces or building blocks and make a structure.
- A total of will be given 60 minutes to complete this activity.

MATHEMAGIX (Mental Maths) U8 / U11 / U14 / U17

- This is an individual event conducted in 2 rounds for U13 & U16.
- Round 1 will be a written elimination round.
- In Round 2 the top contenders will then go through a series of verbal rounds to solve mathematical problems with increased difficulty levels.

GRIDX (Sudoku) U14 / U17

- This is an individual event.
- Participants will be given written puzzles to solve in the shortest amount of time.

SCIENTIFIX (Science Fair) U11 / U14 / U17

- This is an individual event which requires prior planning and all instruments/gadgets/materials must be carried by the participant.
- An experiment /demonstration must be conducted live with 30 minutes of setup time and should be explained to the judges in 1 minute only.
- No use of fire or electric supply is allowed. (No glue guns)

SMARTEX (Quiz) U14 / U17

- This is an individual eventconducted in 2 rounds.
- Round 1 will be a written elimination round.
- In Round 2 the top contenders will then go through a verbal round.

XCELLERATE (Video Presentation) Any Age Group

- An XYZ Group can put up 1 team with 6 members only.
- Each member must be present in the video.
- A video needs to be prepared for minimum 3 minutes and maximum 5 minutes.
- 30 seconds of footage is allowed without a member present.
- Topic: A day in a Parsi Colony through your eyes.
- The final video must be sent on email to **info@xyzfoundation.net** before Saturday, 10th November 2018. **(Delay will lead to negative marking)**
